

Communiqué XRB 3 - 29 August 2011

Public Attendance at XRB, NZASB and NZAuASB Meetings

As reported in Communiqué XRB 2, the XRB Board has agreed that those portions of meetings relating to standards or standards strategy should be open to the public. This will apply to all XRB, NZASB and NZAuASB meetings from September 2011 onwards.

This communiqué outlines the arrangements for public attendance at meetings. Given the importance of this matter the communiqué has been sent to everyone on the XRB, NZASB and NZAuASB subscriber lists. We apologise if you have therefore received this communiqué more than once.

Attendance Arrangements

The arrangements surrounding attendance at Board meetings are outlined on the [Public Attendance](#) page of the XRB website. In short, any person may attend those portions of Board meetings that are designated as public sessions provided that they have registered to attend no later than 48 hours prior to the meeting concerned. Attendance is as an observer only and no-one attending may participate in, or speak at, the meeting. Details about the registration process together with the protocols that will apply at meetings are on the [Public Attendance](#) page.

Board agendas and agenda papers will be posted on the website approximately one week before each Board meeting. A separate webpage for each of the three Boards has been established as part of the [Board Meetings](#) section of the XRB website. The minutes and related communiqué from each meeting will be able to be accessed in a similar way subsequent to each meeting.
