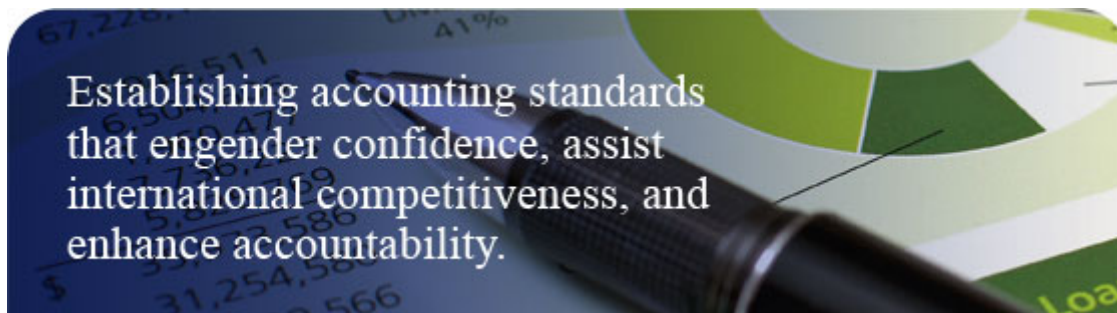

NZASB Questionnaire - IASB's Agenda Consultation 2011

Dear NZASB Subscribers and other interested parties (apologies for multiple posting)

As you are no doubt aware, the International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) has recently published a document entitled "Request for Views *Agenda Consultation 2011*". The purpose of the document is to seek input from the IASB's international constituency (including New Zealand) about what should be included in the IASB's work programme for the next three to five years.

The New Zealand Accounting Standards Board (NZASB) considers the issue of the Request for Views (RV) an important opportunity for the New Zealand constituency to make its views about priorities known to the IASB. Accordingly the NZASB intends to make a submission to the IASB on the RV. In doing so the NZASB is keen to ensure that it has a good understanding of the views of stakeholders within the New Zealand constituency as to what those priorities should be.

To assist the constituency to provide us that feedback in a low effort way, the NZASB staff has prepared the attached questionnaire where constituents can indicate, for each project, whether they consider the IASB should accord it a High, Medium or Low priority.

We would be most grateful if you would take a moment or two to complete the questionnaire on line by following [this link](#). It should only take a few minutes to complete and we would be grateful if you would do this no later than 31 October 2011 - sooner would be great.

Constituents are also welcome to send the NZASB other feedback on the RV in whatever form is easiest to you e.g. email - a formal submission is not required. Please send such feedback to submissions@xrb.govt.nz.

Constituents are also welcome to send feedback directly to the IASB - the deadline for this is 30 November 2011. The NZASB would be grateful if you would send it a copy of any comments made directly to the IASB.
